



Thank you for your faithful and generous support of our church.

During the month of August, your donations to the church's General Fund:

- Provided staff, volunteers, space and support for our new Alpha class that started on August 2. 4 volunteer leaders and 16 students are attending this Thursday night class.
- Provided space and support for our Preschool, with classes for the 2018-2019 year starting on August 6 and 7. This school year we have 4 preschool classes with a total of 50 children, plus 2 parent tot classes with a total of 9 adult/child pairs, and 2 Lunch Bunch groups.
- Provided staff, volunteers, space and support for our new Wednesday night support group, Family Grace, which started on August 8. This group provides support for families impacted by mental illness. 74 people are attending this support group.

Without your gifts, we could not do this work which is all focused on our Mission "To Lead People of All Ages on the Journey to Become Deeply Devoted Followers of Jesus"!

Many thanks to everyone who responded to the letter that was mailed to the congregation at the end of June, requesting pledges or financial gifts to enhance our financial stability through the end of 2018. To date we have received a total of \$36,290 in one-time gifts and weekly/monthly pledge increases. What an outstanding response! This has been a huge help in getting us through these summer months.
