Thank you for your faithful and generous support of our church. During the month of November, your donations to the church's General Fund:

• Provided staff, volunteers, support and our sanctuary for the Gilbert Interfaith Thanksgiving Service on November 20. 165 people attended, including choirs and speakers from our church and other churches in our community. It was a wonderful way to kick off the Thanksgiving holiday.

• Provided staff, volunteers, supplies, and support for our 2018 Turkey Drive. On November 20, 23 volunteer families delivered 103 turkey dinners to families in need in our community.

## A note from the Desert Southwest Conference Changes in stock donation processing

Well, last month was all about being thankful for our family and friends. It is a time to be thankful for the life bestowed upon us. Time for thanking God for each and every second we are given to share and care for one another. As we approach the end of the year and the busy time for gift giving, we are making the below suggestion as it relates to securities donations.

All mutual fund gifts will be processed on a best efforts basis after December 15, 2018. We kindly ask that you please encourage your donors to make their donations of these types of securities prior to December 15 if they wish to receive their tax credit for 2018. We will continue to make our best efforts to ensure a smooth transfer for donors. Please follow the instructions for stock transfers.

1. You or your financial advisor MUST provide us with the following: Security Information: Security Name, Number of Shares, and Symbol/Ticker/Cusip. Security Delivering Institution Information: Security delivering institution name, contact name, phone, e-mail address.

2. Provide us with your complete name, address, city, state, and zip code so that we may send you proper IRS documentation for your gift. In addition, please instruct DSUMF as to any designations of the funds realized after our sale of your gifted securities.

3. The necessary information numbered on 1. And 2. above may be sent to DSUMF via e-mail (accounts@dscumc.org) or fax (602-265-1524). All the preceding information must be received at least three business days before the expected date of the transfer.

4. Please instruct your financial institution to transfer securities to:

5. Once sold they will further credit DSUMF who will then disburse the funds realized per your designation and send you the documentation for your gift required by the IRS.



Yes, we know that Christmas is all about Jesus' birthday, but do your preschoolers know? It will be a new idea to some of them. We have the best jobs in the world as parents and small group leaders because we get to share with preschoolers for the first time that Christmas is all about Jesus' birthday! Jesus has a birthday? Yep! He sure does! And, we are going to Celebrate it BIG! We also want our preschoolers to know that the reason we celebrate Jesus' birthday is because Jesus is God's Son. God's Son deserves a Celebration as big as Christmas and a birthday bash as big!

#### Elementary and preteens:

#### WEEK 1

We kick off the month with the greatest verse in all of Scripture, **John 3:16**. God loves the world so much that He wants to spend forever with us. That was made possible through Jesus!

Bottom Line: God did something about our greatest need. Jesus was God's gift to the world. We pray that kids start to understand their need for a Savior and put their trust in Jesus.

#### WEEK 2

Next, we look at Luke 1:26-56, when Gabriel Came and made a huge announcement to Mary. God was about to rescue the world through Jesus, and she had an important role to play. Mary was overwhelmed by God's love for the world and the part she got to play by fulfilling God's plan to send a Savior.

Bottom Line: God can use anyone to meet others' needs. For whatever reason, kids may feel like God can't use them to show others His love. We hope they see through the story of Mary, that God can use anyone to show His compassion to the world.

#### WEEK 3

In week three we head to Luke 2:1-7 to the familiar moment when Jesus is born. Even though Jesus was born where the animals stayed, God took Care of all the details. The Savior of the World was born, and God's compassion for us was on full display.

Bottom Line: God gave us the greatest gift. God had been planning a rescue since the very beginning. Jesus was God's greatest gift to make it possible for all people to be with God forever.

WEEK 4

Please join us for a birthday party for Jesus!

#### WEEK 5

We finish our month on compassion in **1 John 4:9-12**, where we read about God's great love for us when He sent Jesus to pay the price for our sins. John reminds us that no one has ever seen God, but when we show love to others, people see God through us.

Bottom Line: Love others because God loved you first.
