


Adult Education Classes starting in January:

THE RICHARD AND JULIA WILKE INSTITUTE FOR DISCIPLESHIP

Wed. Nights with meal at 5:45, classes at 6:30, Begins January 8

After careful deliberation and a recommendation from the clergy in the area, Pastor Rick and I have decided that it is important that we change direction in January and teach a 6 week course called "Faithful and Inclusive- The Bible, Sexuality, and the United Methodist Church". This curriculum is offered through the Richard and Julia Wilke Institute for Discipleship (creators of Disciple series) and is meant to help UMC churches prepare for General Conference 2020. Pastor Rick and I are constantly receiving emails asking for more information regarding the subject and many of the churches in the conference have either done this curriculum or are planning it for January. The

Revelation and Wesley or Trinity classes will be held after Lent.



The six-part video series evolved out of study sessions that Rev. Dr. Fuquay led in his church earlier this year. Unable to find United Methodist curriculum that addresses the handful of Bible passages used to form church policy, Fuquay developed his own, employing a Wesleyan approach to biblical interpretation.

Adapted from those church sessions, the video series is designed to help participants learn what the Bible says and then form their own opinions. All six parts allow ample time for thoughtful discussion, as well as moving faith stories of LGBTQ United Methodists and their family members.

"I know this is an issue that many people shy away from, but this study was created with the conviction that it's time for every United Methodist to engage in this discussion," Fuquay said. "The future of the denomination is now at risk. Only the people in the pews can offer any hope for healing and resolution."

Pastors Rick and Diamond will be leading this study.
