Driving during dustorms

Monsoon season begins mid-June and ends September 30th, bringing with it some beautiful, but often unpredictable potentially dangerous weather conditions. From heavy rain causing slick roads and low visibility to large dust storms causing near blackout conditions on the highways – monsoon driving can be extremely dangerous. Monsoon storms can come and go quickly so it is best to check the weather along your travel route prior to hitting the road. Wait out the storm, remember they often pass by very quickly, so you can get back on the road safely in little time. Your safety is worth it.

Here are some suggestions for driving on wet roads or during a dust storm.

- WEAR YOUR SEATBELT!
- Dust Storms Immediately check traffic around your vehicle, (front, back, sides) and begin slowing down.
- Completely exit the highway if you can. Do not wait until poor visibility to pull off the roadway.
- DO NOT STOP in a travel lane or emergency lane. Pull completely off the paved portion of the roadway.
- Turn off all vehicle lights. You don't want others to follow you by using your lights as a guide.
- Set your emergency brake and take your foot off the brake
- Stay in your vehicle with your seatbelts buckled.
- Be patient, wait for the storm to pass.
- Visit Pull Aside-Stay Alive
- Make sure you and your passengers are all properly restrained.

Summer-time Mission Opportunities

Trapper-Keeper Drive: We hope that we can once again help out the children attending Gilbert Elementary School by providing them with the tools they need to be successful. Heat Center Collection Items: Beginning July 23rd—August 27th, the Mission Team will be collecting bottled water and sunscreen. Each Sunday, these items can be dropped off in the Narthex (entrance to Sanctuary) or dropped off at the church office. These items will be distributed to local Heat Centers that provide supplies to homeless individuals during these critically hot months in Arizona. Donations will be distributed to the Justa Center and the Wesley UMC Heat Center.

Family Promise: The Mission Team is striving to figure out all the components so we could be ready to host at least one week in 2024 for Family Promise. This is a week where we host families who are working towards there goal of having their own place to live. During the week we host the overnight and provide meals to families. A Always read a bedtime story... and a mid-morning story, when

the kids aren't too tired! If they want to read the same story over and over, then follow their lead and go for it! If they want to "read" the book and it's not completely accurate, it's ok! Let them pretend to read!

"As your young child listens to stories, he learns that all good stories have a beginning, middle, and end. He also learns to predict, based on the book cover, what the story will be about, as well as what might happen next or how the story will end. Young children learn that there are characters in stories and a particular setting (where and when it takes place). Your child will enjoy comparing the

The next Youth Council Meeting, Sunday July 9th, after church at 10:45am. Anyone is welcome to attend, come help us plan the next few months of youth activities.



> Judy will be leading the review of this fiction book which was published in 2021.


