Starting the new year with a passion for Bible Study!


Choir Sunday School




We Make the Road by Walking



Blood Drive in Activity Center on February 4, 2024 Please Give if you are able!

Meet Avari. This precious little girl received her first blood transfusion when she weeks 3 weeks old. Her parents met with a hematologist there to discuss a possible diagnosis. At five weeks old, they received the devastating news; Avari was born with Diamond Blackfan Anemia (DBA), a rare blood disorder that prevents her body from producing red blood cells. Avari's doctors put her on a course of transfusion therapy. She gets blood tests every three to four weeks, and if her blood counts are low, they make the 2 1/2-hour drive to the children's hospital for a red cell transfusion. "Avari lives on borrowed blood," her mom Anya said. "I am so thankful for blood donors. If people didn't give regularly, my daughter



might not be here today." So far, Avari has received more than 100 red cell transfusions. The family makes regular visits to their local lab along with follow up treatment at the hospital, with more monitoring, testing and transfusions in her future. "She can usually go 3 to 5 weeks in between trips to the hospital," Anya said. "I'm so grateful to the blood donors who have kept my angel alive. Without their selfless acts of kindness, I would not be able to watch her grow." Her mom tells us that Avari makes new friends wherever she goes and loves to sing songs nearly every moment of her life. "Even on hard days, she is still the most loving, happiest child you'll ever meet."





Our hope is to have a large group to add into the discussions. Please feel free to invite a friend or neighbor to the workshop.


